Alexander the Great

I. Macedonia

- Macedonians were culturally and ethnically related to the Greeks.
 - Archelaus ruled as an enlightened monarch for the Greeks of Athens, Sparta, etc.
- King Philip II of Macedonia
 - Expanded the territory north to the Danube River and south into the Greek peninsula
 - Conquered all city-states except Sparta by 338 BCE
 - Albion while planning to attack Persia (336 BCE)

II. Alexander the Great

- Named by the philosopher Aristotle
- Procurator philosopher because his mother was not Macedonian (making Alexander half Macedonian), and his father took a Macedonian as his wife
- Warrior of his country Persia like his father
- Remembered the greatest Greek culture throughout the world
- Philip was killed by conspirators of Alexander
- Alexander came to the throne at age 20 (336 BCE)

III. Conquests of Alexander the Great

- First and oldest land empire, including destroying Thebes
- Invasion of Persia and Egypt
 - 50000 troops
 - Graecia (334 BCE)
 - India (325 BCE)
 - Araby (325 BCE)
 - Cities along the Mediterranean Sea
 - Phoenician Tyre
 - Egypt
 - Founded Alexandria
 - India
 - Reached Indus River
 - Set up capital in Babylon (located in modern-day Iraq) in 324 BCE
- Died of a fever in 323 BCE at age 33

IV. Alexander's empire

- Full extent of Alexander's death
- General fought for control of empire
- Empire divided
 - Egypt = Ptolemy
 - Most of Asian empire = Seleucus
 - Macedonia and Greece = Antigonus
- New dynasties ruled for hundreds of years until conquered by Rome

V. Alexander's impact on world history

- "Spread" Greek culture beyond the Greeks
 - "Hellenism"

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
